Classroom Etiquette:

- Students should arrive early and be waiting for class to begin.
- If the studio is available, the students may enter and prepare for class.
- If the student is 15 minutes or later to the scheduled class, the student will be asked to observe the remainder of the class.

Attendance Policy:

- Excused absences are allowed for JET-PAC and/or Juxtapose Arts Collective Production Weeks/Rehearsals.

Dress Code:

- Ballet/Conditioning (Female): Designated class leotard (the assigned color and order form will be emailed to the class), pink convertible tights, pink ballet/pointe shoes, hair tightly secured in a bun.
- Ballet/Conditioning (Male): White fitted shirt, black tights, black ballet shoes.
- Contemporary: Any color leotard, dance bottoms (leggings, yoga pants, dance shorts, tights, etc.), hair neatly secured, socks or jazz shoes (at the request of your instructor).

- Tap: Any color leotard, dance bottoms (leggings, yoga pants, dance shorts, tights etc.), hair neatly secured, black Bloch jazz taps or tan heel taps (at the request of your instructor).
- FORM: Pink Leotard of any style, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, black tap shoes, pink skirt (optional), Hair secured in a bun
- Musical Theatre/Theatre Dance: Any athletic wear, hair neatly secured, jazz shoes or character shoes (at the request of your instructor).
- Aerial/Lyra: Any color leotard, dance shorts, hair neatly secured, bare feet.
- Hip Hop: Any athletic wear, hair neatly secured, tennis shoes.
- Acting/Film Making/Stage Craft/Audition Prep/Stage Make-up: Any athletic wear, hair neatly secured, jazz or tennis shoes.
- Vocal Performance/Glee Club/Song Composition: Any athletic wear, hair neatly secured.
